Competition Overview

The Business Women's Championship is an annual 18-hole Stroke Play event open to all eligible players. Trophies/prizes are awarded to Gross and Nett winners and runners-up in up to three Divisions. Trophies are limited to one per player.

Governance

- The Championship is managed by WGGC and conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2023), the WGGC Hard Card (March 2024) and the 2024 Championship Playing Conditions.
- At the venue, the Match Committee of the day shall consist of one representative from the host club and the onsite WGGC Match Committee representatives. Rules issues and disputes or claims are to be resolved by the Match Committee of the day.
- The host club is asked to provide officials to act as starter and spotters if applicable.

Format

- 18-hole Stroke Play – Gross and Nett in divisions determined by the number of entries.
- In the event of a tie, the winners will be decided on the GA count back system.

Player Eligibility

The Championship is open to WGGC Inc affiliated members who hold a current GA handicap and are financial members of the club they represent. Players should be full-time or part-time paid or volunteer workers, or tertiary students.

Entry Fees:

- Burleigh Members - \$20.00 (walking)
- Non-Burleigh Members - \$45.00 (walking)

Specific Playing Conditions

This is a non-compulsory cart event. Organisation and payment of hired motorised carts is the responsibility of players. Cart bookings are via the Burleigh Proshop. Cart fees:

- Burleigh Members - \$35 per cart
- Non-Burleigh Members - \$45 per cart

There are no restrictions on the use of motorised carts. Note that Burleigh has limited carts, please walk if you can.
