Event conducted over two rounds (one round for Veterans) to determine the 2024 District Champion and Veterans Champion Golfers in three Divisions. The handicap spread and prize allocation for each Division will depend on the number of entries received. One major trophy per player for all Divisions. Prizes to be awarded as follows.

Governance

- The event is managed by WGGC and conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf (Effective January 2023), the WGGC Hard Card (January 2023 update) and the 2024 event Playing Conditions.

- At each venue the Match Committee of the day shall consist of one representative from the host club and the onsite WGGC Match Committee representatives. Rules issues and disputes or claims are to be resolved by the Match Committee of the day.
- Host clubs are asked to provide officials and spotters if applicable.

- A tie in the Championship (lowest overall Gross score) will be decided by sudden death play-off from the first hole or as determined by the WGGC Match Co-ordinator until a result is achieved. All other ties are to be decided by the GA countback system.
- GA handicaps will remain the same for both rounds (36 holes) of the Championships. For daily events current GA handicaps will apply.

Player Eligibility

The event is open to WGGC Inc. members who hold a current GA handicap and are financial members of the club they represent and their club is a fully financial member of WGGC. Proof of handicap is to be provided on request.

Entry Fees (per player walking)

Championship + Vets – Non-member Coolangatta/Tweed or Parkwood - \$80

Championship Only – Non-members Coolangatta/Tweed or Parkwood - \$80

Championship + Vets – Member Coolangatta/Tweed - \$50

Championship Only – Member Coolangatta/Tweed - \$50

Championship + Vets – Member Parkwood - \$40

Championship Only – Member Parkwood - \$40

Vets Only – Non-member Coolangatta/Tweed - \$40

Vets Only – Member Coolangatta/Tweed - \$10

Motorised Carts

Eligibility for use of either private or hired motorised carts is detailed the WGGC Hard Card (Jan 23). Hiring/payment of carts is via the venue Proshop. Cart costs:

Coolangatta/Tweed – Visitors & members - \$35 per cart

Parkwood – Visitors & members - \$40 per cart

Captains are to ensure all their players are familiar with the playing conditions, the Rules of Golf in relation to Stroke play and the WGGC Hard Card.
