NOTE - Players may nominate in one Division only.

Special hole-in-one prize for the 54 hole stroke event only. A Prize will be awarded to the first hole- in-one scored on the nominated hole. This prize accumulates annually if not won. \$400.00 in 2025

Players may win ONE "Daily" prize each day and one Major 54 Hole prize in each division.

All divisions will play the Women's Red course.

GA Handicap -

CLASSIC - up to 9.3 DIVISION 1, 2 & 3 – up to 26.0

N.B.: Divisions will be determined when registration is closed on 11 July

Conditions of Play

- 1. The event will be played over 54 holes stroke play between Monday 21 July 2025 and Wednesday 23 July 2025 inclusive.
- 2. The Rules of Golf and the Local Rules of Surfers Paradise Golf Club (SPGC) shall be the rules of play during the tournament.
- 3. The decision of the Tournament Match Committee shall be final in all matters relating to the Tournament. Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing at the clubhouse before 6pm on the day on which the dispute has arisen.
- 4. Handicaps must be Golf Australia or World Handicap System.
- 5. Entrants whose handicap increases <u>after the closing date</u> are eligible to play in the tournament off a GA handicap limit of 9.3 for the Classic and 26.0 for Division 3.
- 6. Entries will close 11 Jul 2025 unless the field reaches capacity of 120 players prior, after which a waitlist will be created.
- 7. Players retain the same handicap throughout the tournament.
- 8. In 18 hole events, a tie is decided by a count back. In the 54 hole nett event a tie will be decided by countback on the last 18 holes. In the event of a tie, the 54 hole gross will be decided by sudden death playoff over holes 10, 5 & 9.
- 9. In the Mixed Foursomes, ties will be decided by the count back system.
- 10. All Professionals playing in the mixed foursomes will play off their respective tees (red for women, blue for men) and off GA Handicap.
- 11. Draws and starting times will be available on the SPGC website. The draw is final and is not to be changed at the tee without authorisation from the Starter.
- 12. The organiser may retain personal details of entrants for sending advice on future events. This information will not be available to any other organisation.
- 13. It is a condition of entry that players agree to pictures or references to them being used for publicity purposes and on social media.
- 14. Prizes not collected within 3 months of the tournament will be forfeited.
- 15. One entry per player must be submitted on the online registration form and accompanied by full payment. No entries will be accepted by phone or verbally. Entry assistance is available by phoning Jonna at SPGC (Ph: 07 5575 1666) or Kylie Heaslip or Annie Wade (details below).
- 16. Classic players must walk at all times during a stipulated round, unless a valid medical certificate is provided to the organisers prior to start of play. Caddies are permitted but must walk.
- 17. Mobile phone usage allowed for scoring and emergency only. Only Golf Australia approved tournament distance measuring devices are allowed on the course. Slope and wind capability must be <u>turned off</u> during play
- 18. Pace of play (Rule 5.6) will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain their position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. If called up on a Par 3, you must comply. **Penalties apply**.
- 19. MiScore or hardcard may be used for scoring. Scorecards to be marked with result following each hole. Player may be approached by a SPGC representative requesting progressive scores for media release. Final score must be submitted within 15 minutes of completion of your round.
- 20. Consumption of alcohol is not permitted during all rounds from 21 to 23 July 2025.
